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


Database

 NUTS II





















2001-2007 change by sectors








Types of districts by sectors' importance shift during 2001 – 2007




Spatial distribution of job opportunities




2001-2007 territorial "shift" of jobs




2001-2007 territorial "shift" of jobs in I. sector
